

Community Water Supply Projects

In 2025, many communities across the Eastern Cape are without access to water for weeks and months at a time. Governmental water supply to the neighbouring communities of Paterson and Alicedale is erratic and unreliable. This leads to health risks and severe discomfort for our staff and residents residing in these communities.



Threats faced by communities without water:

- Limited/no drinking water
- Severe health hazards
- Economic and essential service decline

The Shamwari Foundation helps combat these threats by:

- Supply of 5,000 litre drinking water tanks per household
- Supply of 10,000 litre domestic water tanks per household
- Installation and fittings to households and schools
- Water management education and guidelines
- Training on disinfection for drinking water
