Passionate about rhino conservation, Shamwari employs an expertly trained anti-poaching unit. However, poaching regimes have become increasingly sophisticated, and ongoing upgrades to monitoring and tracking equipment are needed to stay a step ahead of poachers.



Threats faced by black/white rhinos:

- Poaching and illegal wildlife trade
- Corruption and criminal gangs
- Habitat loss caused by human encroachment

Rhino projects protect rhinos by:

- Highly-qualified anti-poaching teams
- Real-time AI-technology/GPS tracking using *Rouxcel Rhino Watch Foot Collars*
- Wounded rhino VHF radio tracking devices
- Rescue, treatment, and rehabilitation
- Community partnerships and education
- Pioneering the development of crime syndicate monitoring systems
